No cell phones, smart watches or electronic devices on camp. Teachers will take plenty of photographs and upload them to our Microsoft Teams page (your son has access to this – Ohakune Outdoors Camp, 2023).

Dress for departure is 'camp gear', not school uniform.

Please check the **gear list** he was given (electronic copy is on our Microsoft Teams page). A decent RAIN coat is essential. We have some to loan if necessary, but we must know before we depart. A small backpack/daypack (such as a school bag) is very useful for all excursions.
