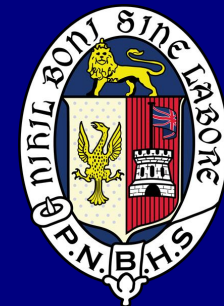

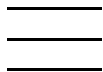

**On this programme, we will raft white water on the Rangitikei River.**

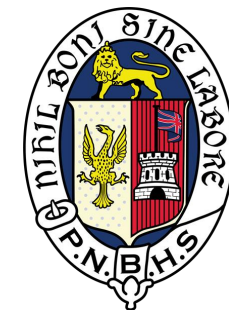




On our best weather days, we will drop into the most beautiful valley in the Tongariro region – the Mangaturuturu, following the Cascades down to where three rivers meet.







**We will camp in or around the Mangaturuturu Hut (Whanganui Tramping Club), the hut with the most amazing views in the national park, of Ruapehu**

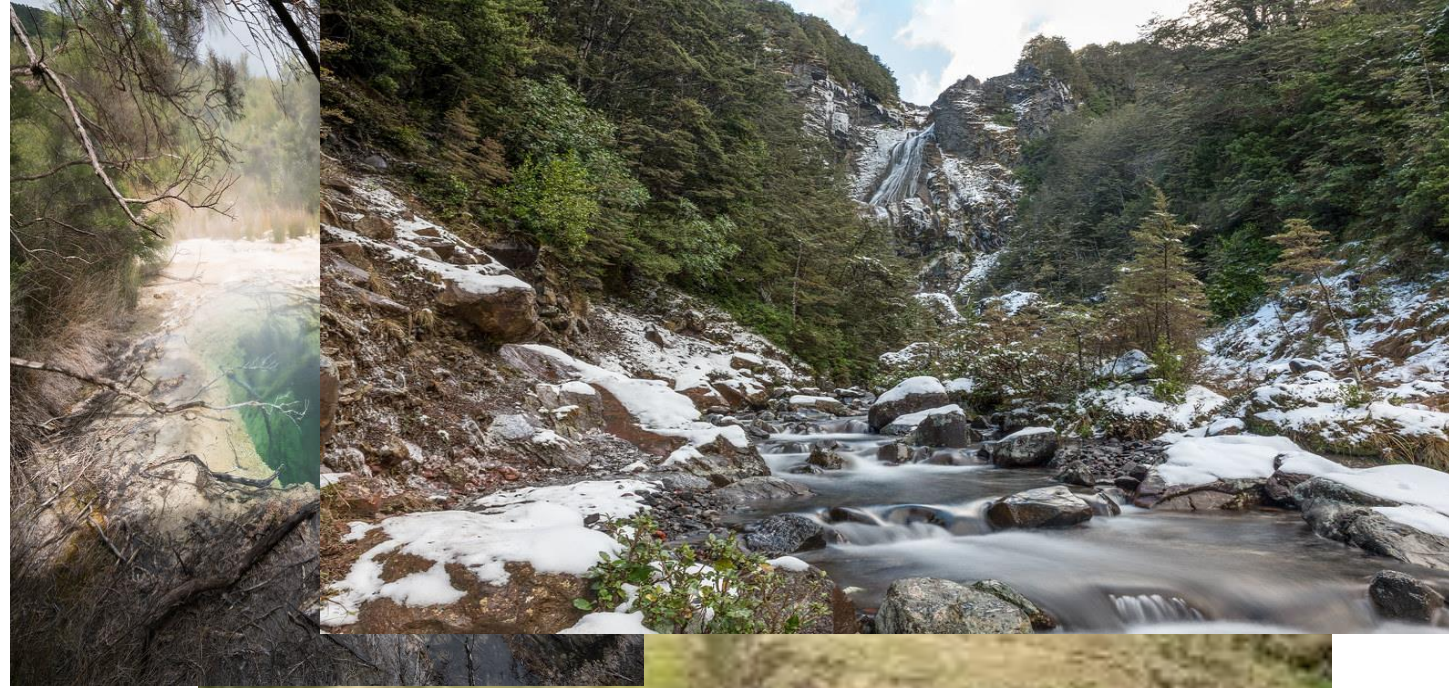
