NZ Super 8 Schools Badminton Tournament 2020 – Event Information

Venue Information

The 2020 Super 8 Badminton will be held at Pettigrew Green Arena; 480 Gloucester Street, Taradale, Napier. Car parking and entry is available at the REAR carpark. Subway is available and open throughout the event.

Managers Meeting

A Managers meeting will be held at 8:30am, upstairs in the PGA Board Room. It is compulsory that all team managers attend.

Team Lists & Tie Sheets

All Team Managers must have submitted their Team Ranking lists prior to the Managers Meeting which includes the singles and all possible doubles combinations, in ranking order.

Team Managers will be required to nominate their singles and doubles pairings 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the next tie.

Ten minutes prior to the start of the tie, the Tie sheet and scoresheets will be available for Team Managers to collect. Additional blank scoresheets will also be available at the Tournament Desk.

We ask if all scoresheets can be signed off by both Team Managers, scores recorded to the Team Tie Sheet, and the scoresheet submitted to the Tournament Desk. All scores will be updated to Tournament Software throughout the event.

Sportsmanship and Umpiring

A friendly reminder to all teams that we expect them to play fairly and show good sportsmanship.

All players will be expected to umpire matches throughout the event. Umpiring scoresheets will be available and are to be completed for every match.

Registration

There is a \$395 registration fee. This will be invoiced to your school after the tournament and will cover the cost of stadium hire and shuttles.

First Aid

Each team will be required to provide their own first aid kit and ice packs.

Regulations:

1. Each team shall consist of a minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 6 players and these players must be the same for the duration of the tournament.

2. A Tie consists of 4 singles and 2 doubles matches.

3. Each match is played to the best of three games of 21 points. If a game is tied at 20-20, a player must win by two points, until a maximum of 30 points. Example, if a game is tied at 29-29 all, the player to reach 30 points wins the game.

4. A player cannot play more than one singles and one doubles match per tie.

5. Each team will submit their Team Ranking List by Thursday 27th August, which must list all players for singles, and all possible doubles combinations in order of merit. Any updates or changes to the lists can be submitted at the Managers Meeting.

6. Any matches defaulted in a Tie other than due to injury or illness will automatically be defaulted by that team for the remainder of the tournament. Example, if a team cannot sufficiently field 4 singles players in their first tie, all '4th Boys Singles' are defaulted for all remaining ties.

7. If a player becomes incapacitated and is unable to continue during a tie, the match in progress will be forfeited. If a team consists of more than the minimum number of players, a player may be substituted in the incapacitated player's position, in the remaining matches provided they do not exceed their number of matches per tie (Regulation 4).

8.. Team Managers must submit their team sheet to the Tournament Desk, 30 minutes prior to the start of the next tie.

9. The order of play for the tie is;

- Singles in ascending order of merit
- Doubles in ascending order or merit

Unless both Team Managers agree on a different order of play, the order of play will remain as stated above.

10. The winner of a Tie is determined by the team which has the greater number of matches. If the matches are equal, the tie winner will be determined by games. If games are equal, the tie winner will be determined on points. If all matches, games and points are equal, the tie will be declared a draw.

11. The Rules of Play shall be those of the Badminton World Federation, with the BWF scoring system used for all matches. This document is available via the Badminton New Zealand website.

- 12. The placings of the Super 8 Championships are decided by the following criteria order;
 - The Team with greatest number of ties won.
 - The Team with the greatest number of matches won.
 - The highest value of Games won minus Games lost.



• The highest value of Points won minus Points lost.

Presentation

There will be a short presentation following the conclusion of the final ties. All teams are asked to be present and in uniform.
